POTENTIAL HAZARD (DANGER)

• Runoff to sewer may create fire or explosion hazard. • Inhalation or contact with material may irritate or burn skin and eyes. • Fire may produce irritating, corrosive and/or toxic gases. • HIGHLY FLAMMABLE: Will be easily ignited by heat, sparks or flames. • Vapours may form explosive mixtures with air. • Vapours may cause dizziness or suffocation

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

• Protective goggles or face shield. • Protective gloves. • Protective shoes. • Eyewash bottle with clean water. • Respiratory safety device that will allow driver to escape. • Light protective clothing.

DRIVER INTERVENTION EQUIPMENT

• Chemical protective clothing that is specially recommended by the manufacturer. • Dry chemical or CO2. • Sand or other absorbent. • Shovel.

DRIVER FIRST ACTIONS - Only if it can be carried out without personal risk

• Contact emergency services. • Stay upwind, uphill and/or upstream. • Stop the engine. • Avoid contact with spilled material.

DRIVER SPECIAL/ADDITIONAL ACTIONS - Only if it can be carried out without personal risk

• Stop leak if you can do it without risk. • ELIMINATE all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames in immediate area). • Do not touch or walk through spilled material.

DRIVER ACTIONS IN CASE OF FIRE - Only if it can be carried out without personal risk

• Large Fire - Move containers from fire area if you can do it without risk. • Small Fire - Dry chemical, CO2, water spray or regular foam. • CAUTION: All these products have a very low flash point: Use of water spray when fighting fire may be inefficient. • CAUTION: For mixtures containing alcohol or polar solvent, alcohol-resistant foam may be more effective.

FIRST AID

• Give artificial respiration if victim is not breathing. • Remove and isolate contaminated clothing and shoes. • Wash skin with soap and water. • Move victim to fresh air. • In case of contact with substance, immediately flush skin or eyes with running water for at least 20 minutes.
